The funding would be used to construct a certified commercial kitchen facility at the Labor of Love Community Garden in Preston Heights. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will bring permanent, certified food production infrastructure to one of Will County's most underserved communities, creating a public facility that simultaneously addresses food insecurity and expands economic opportunity for residents of Illinois' 14th Congressional District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
